# PETITION FOR APPLICATION OF WRIT OF MANDAMUS

Comes now, the Petitioner by counsel and moves this Court for a Writ of Mandamus to be issued against the Respondent for the reasons state below:

- The Petitioner is a resident of Clintwood, Virginia which is located in the 38<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District in Virginia.
- 2. Ralph Northam is the duly elected Governor of Virginia.
- On January 1, 2021, Ben Chaffin, the duly elected state Senator for the 38<sup>th</sup> Senatorial
   District of Virginia died creating a vacancy as defined by 24.2-216 of the Code of
   Virginia.
- 4. Senator Chaffin was a Republican.
- 5. Governor Northam is a Democrat.
- 6. When Delegate Joe Lindsey, a Democrat, became a judge on November 9, 2020, the Respondent initially set a special election on December 1, 2020, which later changed to January 5, 2021 which was before the start of the General Assembly Session. Exhibit A.

- 7. When Delegate Jennifer Foy, a Democrat, resigned from the House of Delegates on December 8, 2020, the Governor set a special election on January 5, 2021 which was before the start of the General Assembly Session. Exhibit B.
- 8. On January 12, 2021 the Respondent set a special election to fill the vacancy for the vacancy of Senator Chaffin on March 23, 2021. Exhibit C.
- 9. The Virginia General Assembly begins its 2021 session on January 13, 2021 and is expected to last 30 days.
- 10. As a result of the death of Senator Chaffin, the 38<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District will not have representation during the entire session as the Respondent is setting a date to fill the vacancy on March 23, 2021.
- 11. 24.2-216 of the Code of Virginia mandates the governor "shall issue a writ of election" to fill the vacancy and pursuant to 24.2-683 of the Code of Virginia, the election shall be published in certain places for at least 10 days before the election.
- 12. After 11 days of delay (January 1, 2021 January 12, 2021), the Governor set a date for a Special Election on March 23, 2021 to fill the vacancy of Senator Chaffin.
- 13. The actions of the Governor were designed specifically to divest the 38<sup>th</sup> Senatorial

  District from representation in the General Assembly and has been done with political motivation and in bad faith with an expectation that the replacement of Senator

  Chaffin would be a Republican.
- 14. The Petitioner suffers irreparable harm, for which no other remedy at law exits, caused by the Governor to divest the Petitioner of representation in the Virginia Senate during the 2021 General Assembly session in the 38th Senatorial District when

constituents in primarily Democrat districts have seen expedited elections to ensure representation of Democrat Districts in the 2021 General Assembly.

- 15. The actions of the Governor are in direct violation of 24,2-216 of the Code of Virginia and constitute political maladministration in violation Article 1 Section 3 of the Virginia Constitution.
- 16. Following either the precedence of the Del. Lindsey or the Del. Foy timelines set in 2020, the Governor should be ordered to set a special election within 21-29 days of January 1, 2021, or as soon as practical thereafter.

Wherefore, the Petitioner prays for this Court to Order the Respondent to immediately file a Writ for Special Election and for the election to occur within 10 days of the Writ.




